Act 1 Scene 1 - Prologue



The lights around the stage are dimly lit. A voice comes from the stage, telling everyone about the story of the magic lamp that is waiting for somebody of kind heart and strong of mind to come and find it.

Are you ready for the panto to begin?



Lightning Strikes! The baddie of the panto,
Abanazar, played by Miles Western, comes
onto the stage. When Abanazar enters, the
audience make a 'boo' noise to show that he is
the baddie.

He tells the audience of his plans to take the magic lamp and become the most powerful man in the world. He must go to Cheltenham and start his masterplan!

He summons his magical guide, The Spirit of the Ring, played by Jessica Martin, to transport him there.

Scene 2 - Cheltenham



The curtain lifts and shows Cheltenham Town in all its sparkling glory.

This scene introduces our cast of goodies, Aladdin played by Luke Suri, Jasmine played by Samira Mighty, Widow Twankey played by Kevin Brewis and Tweedy, played by Tweedy!

These characters will talk to the audience a lot. When the characters speak to the audience, you are welcome to speak or shout back.

If you dont like loud noises, you are welcome to cover your ears.

In the next scene Abanazar appears in Cheltenham, where he meets Jasmine on her way to Twankey's Teashop.

Abanazar asks Jasmine if he knows anybody by the name of Aladdin and she tells him about Twankeys Teashop in Tivoli where Aladdin works.

We then join Tweedy, Jasmine and Aladdin at Twankey's Teashop where Tweedy tells some silly jokes and Aladdin and Jasmine share their feelings with each other.

Scene 3 - A Street In Cheltenham



In this scene Tweedy and Widow Twankey are met by Abanazar and The Spirit of The Ring, who trick Widow Twankey into thinking that Abanazar is Aladdin's long lost Uncle who has come to share his vast amounts of wealth.

Abanazar and Widow Twankey organise a family reunion dinner at the Tea Shop.

Scene 4 - Twankey's Tea Shop



Widow Twankey, Abanazar and Tweedy enter as we visit Twankey's Tea Room. Tweedy gets left in charge of the shop as Twankey and Abanazar go looking for Aladdin.

While making a bubble tea order, Tweedy gets himslef stuck in a massive bubble!

Twankey and Abanazar return to the stage, quickly followed by Aladdin. Abanazar keeps convincing everyone that he is Aladdin's longlost Uncle with the promise of untold riches.

Aladdin now finds out that in exchange for these untold riches, he must find the lamp for Abanazar.

Scene 5 - A Street In Cheltenham



As Tweedy and Aladdin prepare to leave for their extra night classes, Abanazar summons The Spirit of the Ring to help him locate the lamp. We find out that the Room of Treasures, where the lamp is hidden, is at Cheltenham College!

Scene 6 - Classroom at Cheltenham College and The Room of Treasures



Tweedy and Aladdin enter their night school. Tonight, Widow Twankey is their teacher!

Twankey asks both Tweedy and Aladdin questions but silly Tweedy gets all of them wrong!

At the end of their class, Abanazar re-appears. The audience 'boo' again and Aladdin starts to doubt whether Abanazar really is his long-lost Uncle.

Abanazar gives his ring to Aladdin as a token of trust before Aladdin and Tweedy head off alone into the Room of Treasures to find the lamp!



The stage gets dark and the scene changes into the Room of Treasures.

Aladdin and Tweedy look for the magic lamp and come across a big slot machine that they find out is holding the lamp inside! They pull the arm of the slot machine and to try to get the lamp out!

With the lamp found, Abanazar tries to get Aladdin to hand him the lamp. Aladdin refuses, so Abanazar locks Aladdin and Tweedy inside the Room of Treasures!

With no way out of the room, Aladdin calls on the Spirit of the Ring to give them a hand.



With the Spirit unable to get Aladdin and Tweedy out of the Room on her own, Aladdin rubs the lamp to give it a clean.

To everyone's surprise a Genie, played by Sam Holmes, flies out of the lamp and promises Aladdin 3 wishes.

Aladdin's first wish is to transport all of the gold from the room to his Mum, so she will never need to work again.

Aladdin's second wish is to get out of the room, so the Genie gives Aladdin a flying carpet.

As the last action of the first act, the stage goes black and Aladdin flies on his new magic carpet.

Interval



The curtain in front of the Stage comes down and it is now the interval.

You are welcome to use the interval to go to the toilet or to buy some drinks and snacks from the bar or the kiosk.

There will be a bell that rings and an announcement when the show is about to restart.

Please return to your seat and enjoy the Second Act.

Act 2
Scene 1 - A Casino in Cheltenham



We return to Cheltenham but Twankeys Tea Room is now a Casino paid for by the vast riches that Aladdin wished to be sent to his Mum.

Aladdin explains that Abanazar is actually not his Uncle and tried to trap them in the Room of Treasures.

Thinking Abanazar may try to kidnap Jasmine in an attempt to get the lamp, Aladdin and Tweedy go to find her, leaving the lamp with Twankey.

Unfortunately, Abanazar is hiding nearby and sees the lamp being left behind.

Scene 2 - A Street In Cheltenham



After Aladdin and Tweedy find Jasmine, they head back to Twankey's Casino.

Jasmine agrees to look after the lamp, while
Twankey powders her nose. Jasmine doesnt
realise that its a magic lamp and when Abanazar
comes to her dressed up as Lawrence Llewellyn
Bowen, offering to trade the lamp for a newer
one, she agrees!

Now, with the power of the lamp in his hands, Abanazar freezes Jasmine and takes her with him to his new secret palace.

Upon discovering that Jasmine and the lamp are missing, Aladdin, Twankey and Tweedy head to the palace with The Ring's help.

Scene 3 - Night Skies Of Cheltenham



While Aladdin finds his own way to the Palace, Tweedy and Twankey fly above the skies of Cheltenham on magic carpets!

Scene 4 - Abanazar's Palace



We arrive at Abanazar's Palace, where Abanazar is performing 'Viva Las Vegas' by Elvis Presley.

The Spirit of the Ring comes onto Stage, pretending that she has returned to Abanazar, so that he can be her master again.

The Ring produces a gift for Abanazar - which is Tweedy disguised as Massive Mandy! While impressing Abanazar with her beauty, Mandy tries her hardest to distract Abanazar. On her third try to distract him, Mandy's wig falls off, revealing that it was Tweedy all along!



With Abanazar distracted, Aladdin jumps into the scene and Jasmine steals the lamp from Abanazar. She throws the lamp to Tweedy, who juggles it around with 2 fake lamps.

The real lamp ends up with Tweedy, who gives it a rub and is granted 3 wishes by the Genie!

His first wish is to get rid of Abanazar now, and forever!

His second wish is to transport everybody back home.

His final wish is to free the Genie and The Spirit of The Ring.

Scene 5 - Song Sheet



The story of the panto of the panto is now over.

Tweedy comes back on stage and sings a song with the audience.

You are welcome to join in too!

Scene 6 - Walkdown and Rounds of Applause

The pantomime is now over and all of the actors walk to the front of the stage for a bow.

The audience will clap the actors, giving them all a round of applause.

If you enjoyed the show, you are welcome to clap along too.

Once all of the actors have left the stage, the lights in the auditorium will come on and you can leave when a teacher or carer allows you to.
